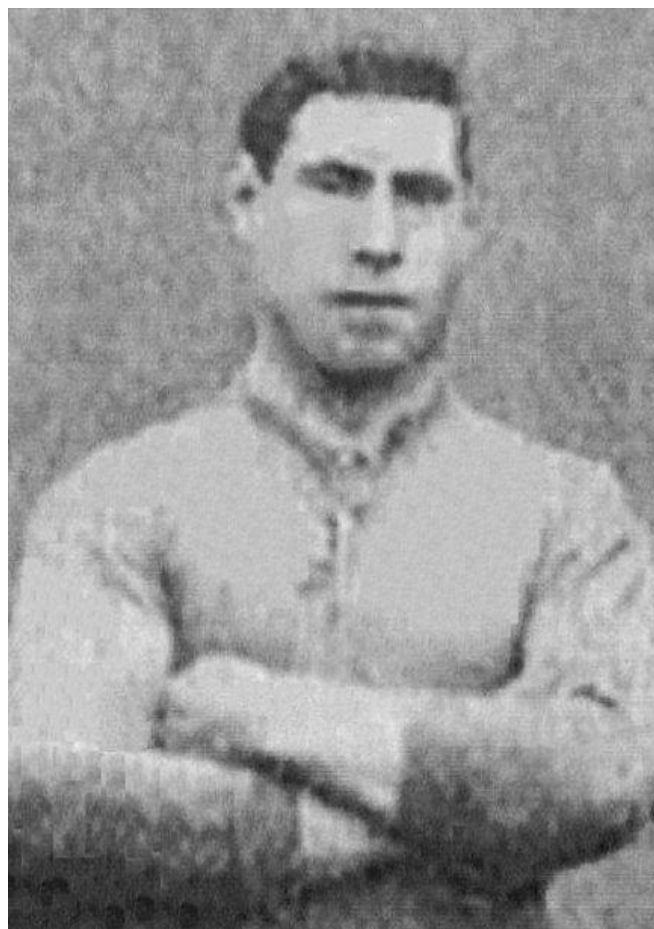


## No.14 Harry 'Nudger' Woodward

Harry, or 'Nudger' as he was nicknamed by Hednesford Town supporters, was born in Gentleshaw in 1887. He and his team-mates were playing at 'The tins' situated behind the Anglesey Hotel prior to his transfer to Burnley, at a cost of £100, in October 1908.

Harry made his League Football debut, 13 March 1909, in the 2-1 defeat away at Wolverhampton Wanderers. Playing at full-back, he managed only that one game in their Division Two side in 1908-09 and two more in the following season before leaving the club in the summer of 1910.
